Bring your reusable cup or request a washable cup when staying in and make sure to mark your cup on the tally sheet located at the counter.

Fun Facts:

Each year, it costs Americans 5.7 billion gallons of water and 9.4 million trees to produce their more than 20 billion single use paper coffee cups.

It takes only 24 refills of a reusable mug, in place of paper coffee cups, to offset the environmental impact of its production. Considering that reusable mugs are designed to be used over 3,000 times, imagine the reduction of environmental impact versus 3,000 paper cups.
