

VOTER IDENTIFICATION

C.R.S. 1-1-104(19.5) outlines identification to vote is:

- Valid Colorado driver's license
- Valid identification card issued by the department of revenue in accordance with part 3 of article 2 of title 42
- Valid United State passport
- Valid employee identification card with a photograph of the eligible elector issued by any branch, department, agency or entity of the US government or of this state, or by any county, municipality, board, authority or other political subdivision of this state
- Valid pilot's license issued by the federal aviation administration or other authorized agency of the US
- Valid United State military identification card with a photograph of the eligible elector
- Copy of a current utility bill, bank statement, government check, paycheck or other government document that shows the name and address of the elector
- Valid Medicare or Medicaid card issued by the United State health care financing administration
- Certified copy of a birth certificate for the elector issued in the united State
- Certified documentation of naturalization or
- Valid student identification card with a photograph of the eligible elector issued by an institution of higher education in Colorado as defined in C.R.S. 23-3.1-102(5)
 - Any form of identification indicated in this list that shows the address of the eligible elector shall be considered identification only if the address is in the state of Colorado
 - Verification that a voter is a resident of a group residential facility, as defined in subsection (18.5) of this section, shall be considered sufficient identification for the purposes of 1-7-110(1)
