### COMINGLED CONTAINER BIN

**OK:** Plastics #1 - #7  
Glass Bottles  
Aluminum Foil/Cans  
Metal Cans

**NO:** Plastic Bags  
Compostable Plastic  
Tops or Lids  
Styrofoam



### NEWSPAPER & MAGAZINE BIN

**OK:** Inserts  
Glossy Paper

**NO:** Cardboard  
Office Paper



### OFFICE PAPER BIN

**OK:** Staples/Paper Clips  
Envelope Windows  
Pastel Paper  
Pastel Sticky Notes

**NO:** Neon Paper  
File Folders



### CARDBOARD BIN

**OK:** Brown Paper Bags  
Corrugated Cardboard

**NO:** Paper Board  
(i.e. cereal boxes)

### DROP THESE OFF AT THE LANDFILL
