WHAT: A free program geared to educate upper-level managers and staff about State and County Noxious Weed Laws and Regulations which can affect the properties you care for. Learn to identify the 30-plus listed Noxious Weeds found in the Roaring Fork Valley (more than just thistles and burrs!) and what options you have to manage them in your gardens, pastures, lawns and wild areas.
