### **ISSUE STATEMENT:**

Each year staff updates the County road list which will be submitted to the State of Colorado for inclusion on the Highway Users Tax Fund (HUTF) Report. This road list is on file in the County Clerk's office.

### **BACKGROUND:**

The road list corresponds with the roads included in the United States Forest Service's Schedule "A" list and the County Road lists in the Pitkin County Asset Management Plan. To be eligible for the funds, a road has to be passable by a two-wheel drive vehicle. The following are changes in the 2010 qualifying roads:

- Vacation of Music School Road

In 2008-2009 Pitkin County relinquished control of Music School Road to the Music School as part of their redevelopment application. The Music School Road was considered for .31 miles towards the HUTF.

Paved roads garnish 1.5 times that of the gravel roads. 110.1 miles of paved roadways and 149.4 miles of unpaved roadways will be included in this year's submission.

### **LINK TO STRATEGIC PLAN:**

**Regional Transportation:** Provide funding necessary to sustain safe, efficient, and high-quality County Roads.

### **BUDGETARY IMPACT:**

Pitkin County expects approximately \$900,000 to be dispersed throughout the Road and Bridge Funds and distributed to local Home Owners Associations. These funds are used for sanding material, vehicle costs, labor costs, and several other Road and Bridge items.
