Landfill Tipping Fees

All incoming items are subject to the appropriate fees as listed below.

We do not accept credit cards.

A cubic yard is length x width x height (in feet) divided by 27. 3'x3'x3' = 1 cubic yard

TRASH

Compactor trucks	\$52.00 ton
Construction Debris - all 3 axle trucks & 10(+) yard roll-offs	\$60.00 ton
All other incoming unsorted material	\$27.30 cu yd
Carrion over 25 lbs	\$25.00 each
Mobile home over 50 ft in length	\$1,000.00 each
Mobile home under 50 ft in length	\$625.00 each

SOIL & ROCK

Clean soil and rock suitable for screening into topsoil	\$2.20 cu yd
Clean soil and rock suitable for crushing into product	\$8.50 cu yd
Clean asphalt (no construction debris)	\$8.50 cu yd

WOOD & ORGANIC WASTES

Leaves and grass clippings	\$15.00 cu yd
Brush and lumber	\$15.00 cu yd
Biosolids	\$25.00 ton

METAL

Miscellaneous scrap	\$15.00 cu yd
Major appliances	\$12.50 each
Motor Vehicles	\$50.00 each

All fluids and trash must be removed and a Vehicle Admission Form obtained from the Sheriff's Office

TIRES

Passenger car and truck and smaller without rim	\$6.00 each
with rim	\$13.50 each
Commercial trucks with or without rim	\$26.50 each

HOUSEHOLD HAZARDOUS MATERIALS

Charges are based on the volume of the container, NOT the amount of waste remaining. You may consolidate like materials.

Commercial: We accept up to 25 gallons of paint and paint related material per month but we do not accept chemicals.

Antifreeze	\$5.00 gallon container
Chemicals, insecticides, etc.	\$5.00 gallon container
Oil and water mixed	\$5.00 gallon container
Used motor oil	\$1.00 gallon container
Paint related material (thinner, etc.)	\$5.00 gallon container
Latex paint	\$5.00 gallon container
Oil base paint/stain	\$5.00 gallon container
Unknown chemical, unmarked	\$8.00 gallon container
Aerosol cans	\$1.00 each
Compact fluorescent bulbs	\$1.00 each
Battery - vehicle	\$1.00 each
Fluorescent bulbs by the foot	\$.50 foot

ELECTRONICS

Small: Mouse, keyboard, cell phone	\$5.00 each
Medium: Desktop printer, microwave, cpu, TV, fax, stereo	\$10.00 each
Large: Commercial copier/printer or complete computer	\$25.00 each

OTHER FEES

Colorado Solid Waste User Fee (collected under C.R.S. §25-16-104.5 and 6 CCR 1007-2 §1.7.3): \$1.30 per ton or \$.39 per cubic yard. Fee applies to all items that go into the permanent landfill.

Regional Waste Management Outreach (collected under Pitkin County Ordinance No. 98-44): \$.33 per ton or \$.10 per cubic yard.

Clean-up fee	\$65.00 per occurrence
Special waste handling fee	\$1.25 cu yd

RECYCLABLE ITEMS

We accept the following items at no charge from households dropping off their own items:

Newspaper, office pack, tin and aluminum cans, glass bottles, plastic containers #1 through #7, phone books, magazines, plastic grocery bags, and cardboard.

SUBSIDIES TO PIKTIN COUNTY RESIDENTS:
