

## WINTER SEASON Route Information

Pitkin County Road & Bridge consists of 10 operators scheduled 5 days a week between 5 am-10 pm.

Snow removal will be prioritized in accordance with our Asset Management Plan. Priorities for weekday mornings will be SCHOOL BUS ROUTES, as well as all First Priority roads. Second Priority roads will be serviced after those priorities have been met. With heavy snow events some second priority roads may be plowed later in the day.

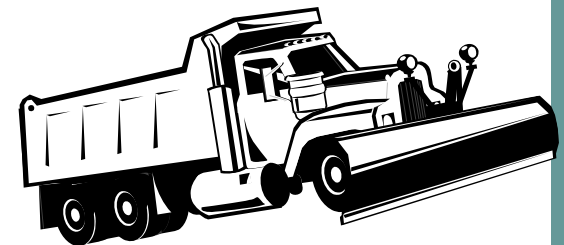

**SNOW DRIVING SAFETY**

1. SLOW DOWN and use caution around snow removal equipment.
2. Maintain a safe following distances behind the plow to help avoid flying snow and sanding material.
3. Stay out of the vehicles blind spots.
4. Turn your headlights on.
5. Flashing Blue Lights on a truck indicate an emergency vehicle and it is illegal to pass.



**OTHER USEFUL REMINDERS**

**ROADSIDE PARKING:**

IS PROHIBITED along all County roads and within any County road right-of-way. Road side parking inhibits thorough plowing and vehicles will be towed without notice.

**PRIVATE PLOWING:**

It is unlawful for any person to deposit snow plowed from a private driveway, road or any other source, onto any County Road per Colorado Revised Statute §43-5-301. Homeowners and Contractors are advised not to push snow across the County Road at any time.

**MAIL BOX POLICY:**

Any installation within the Public right-of-way including Mailbox/Post is placed that the owners risk. Owners are encouraged to install mailboxes at the maximum usable distance from the edge of the roadway. Owners are responsible for replacement of mailboxes or posts damaged by snow plowing operations.

**SNOW IN DRIVEWAYS:**

During snow plow operations there will be times when you driveway receives a wind row of snow. Please be advised it is illegal do shovel the snow back into the roadway.
